
BURST YOUR THIRST WITH BUBBLES UP!



In the United States, less than 10% gets recycled. 6.9 billion tons of plastic have become waste, and 6.3 billion tons of that plastic never reached a recycling bin. In 2015 it was estimated that somewhere between 5.3 million and fourteen million tons of plastic enter the ocean each year from coastal regions alone. It is unsure how long this plastic will take to biodegrade, but estimates suggest between 450 years to never. Nearly 700 marine species have been negatively impacted by plastic in the ocean. The article suggests that the ocean plastic crisis is different than global warming in the sense that there is a known solution to plastic in the ocean. which is to clean up garbage and recycle.
